ORDER DECLARING OAKLEY  
SANITARY DISTRICT DULY  
FORMED AND ESTABLISHED

A petition signed as required by law, having been filed with the said Board of Supervisors of the County of Contra Costa, State of California, on the 2nd day of July, A.D., 1945, praying for the formation, establishment and organization of a Sanitary District to be known as the Oakley Sanitary District, under the provisions of Sections 6400 and 6907.5 inclusive, of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, and the said Board of Supervisors of the said County and the said State, on the 2nd day of July, A.D., 1945, after proceedings duly, legally and regularly had, ordered that an election be held on the 21st day of August, A.D., 1945, between the hours of 7:00 A. M. and 7:00 P. M. within the exterior boundaries of the said proposed Oakley Sanitary District, as said boundaries were duly established by order of the said Board of Supervisors and entered on its minutes on the 2nd day of July, A.D., 1945, and at which said election the following question was ordered submitted to the duly qualified voters of said proposed Sanitary District, to wit:

"Sanitary District - Yes" and

"Sanitary District - No"

and at which said election a Sanitary Assessor and five members of a Sanitary Board were ordered voted upon, and notice of the holding of said election having been given by publishing a copy of the order calling said election once a week for four successive weeks prior to the date of said election, in the "Brentwood News", a newspaper

of general circulation, printed and published in the said County of Contra Costa, State of California, as shown by Affidavit of Publication of Edgar Allen, on file herein, and by posting copies of said order in three conspicuous public places within the boundaries of said proposed Sanitary District, at least four weeks before the date of holding said election as shown by the Affidavit of Posting of Frank Dal Porto on file herein, and the members of the election board appointed by the said Board of Supervisors to conduct said election having filed with the Clerk of the said Board of Supervisors all of the returns of said election held on the said 21st day of August, A.D. 1945, and all provisions of law applicable herein and to this matter having been duly, fully and legally complied with;

The Board of Supervisors of the said County and the said State proceeds to and does canvass the returns of said election and from said returns finds that "Sanitary District - Yes" received one hundred ten (110) votes and "Sanitary District - No" received no votes, and that the following vote was cast for Sanitary Assessor, to wit:

Frank J. Silva received ninety-eight (98) votes and Joe Augusta received one (1) vote, and the following vote was cast for members of a Sanitary Board, to wit:

Joseph M. Augusta received ninety-six (96) votes; Anthony J. Dal Porto received one hundred three (103) votes; Hasten England received ninety-six (96) votes; Jesse Mello received one hundred two (102) votes; Tony C. Vengley received one hundred two (102) votes; Tony Sanchez received five (5) votes; George Christie received one (1) vote; Frank Dal Porto received one (1) vote; and Tony Ramos received one (1) vote.

And it appearing to the said Board of Supervisors that a majority of votes cast at said election were in favor of the formation and establishment of the said Oakley Sanitary District;

On motion of Supervisor Taylor, seconded by Supervisor Ripley, IT IS BY THE SAID BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ORDERED that a Sanitary District to be known as Oakley Sanitary District be and the

same is hereby ordered and declared to be duly and legally formed and established to be composed of the following described territory, to wit:

All that certain territory situate, lying and being in the said County of Contra Costa, State of California, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the center of Section 25 T 2 N R 2 E and running thence West along the midsection line of Sections 25 & 26 to a point on the East line of a 1 rod strip described in Vol. 172 Official Records at page 105, said point being 1633.50 feet West of the line between Sections 25 & 26 T 2 N R 2 E; thence North along said East line to the North line of Section 26; thence West 455.53 feet to the S W corner of that 5.003 acre parcel of land described in the deed to John T. Miguel recorded July 17, 1939 in Vol. 510 OR 194; thence North along the West line of said 5.003 acre tract 1086.60 feet to the South line of the AT & SF Railway right of way; thence continuing North to the northerly line of said R/W; thence S66° 57' E along said northerly line of said R/W to a point 50' west of the projection due North of the westerly line of 3rd Street as shown on the amended map of the town of Oakley filed March 21, 1903 in Map Book "C" page 5 records of Contra Costa County; thence North a distance of 793 feet; thence East to the East line of the West 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 24 T 2 N R 2 E; thence South 0° 43' 30" to a point on the South line of Section 24 which point is 1320.14 feet East of the corner common to Sections 23-24-25-& 26 T 2 N R 2 E; thence East to the S 1/4 corner of Section 24; thence South along the East line of NW 1/4 of Section 25 to the Center thereof and the point of beginning.

And Frank J. Silva having received the highest number of votes cast for Sanitary Assessor of said Sanitary District;

IT IS BY THE SAID BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ORDERED that Frank J. Silva be and he is declared to be the duly elected Sanitary Assessor of the said Oakley Sanitary District to hold office for the term prescribed by law; and Joseph M. Augusta, Anthony J. Dal Porto, Hasten England, Jesse Mello and Tony C. Vengley having received the highest number of votes cast for members of the Sanitary Board of the said Sanitary District;

IT IS BY THE SAID BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ORDERED that the said Joseph M. Augusta, Anthony J. Dal Porto, Hasten England, Jesse Mello and Tony C. Vengley are hereby declared to be the duly elected members of the said Sanitary Board of said Oakley Sanitary District to hold office for the term as prescribed by law.
